The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman J. Millar.

- 1. T. McKeon presented the Selectmen's 2018-19 budget of \$1,931,607, an increase of \$41,883 or 2.2% over last year. Principal components of the increase are (i) regular and winter road maintenance \$20,000 (the latter is running \$28,000 over budget so far this year); (ii) software upgrades for the Assessor and Tax Collector \$5,090; (iii) the additional cost of primary elections next year \$7,080; (iv) higher waste disposal fees \$4,000; and (v) net salaries and benefits \$4,898.
- 2. A preliminary draft of Region 7's 2018-19 budget shows an increase of only 0.9%. Colebrook's share will increase by 4.1% because of relative changes to enrollment. However, the increase is less than was anticipated.
- 3. The current estimates of revenue and expense for 2018-19 result in modest shortfall of \$20,288, even assuming that only half of the Governor's proposed road aid is received this year and next. Reserves should be adequate to cover such a shortfall; so a flat mill rate is still an option for 2018-19.
- 4. The Board received a letter from King, King & Associates requesting their appointment as the Town's auditors for the 2017-18 fiscal year. The matter will be decided at the next meeting.
- 5. D. Johnstone moved to accept the corrected minutes of February 21, 2018. Second, M. Neal. Passed with the abstention of K. Kennedy who was absent.
- 6. M. Neal moved to adjourn. Second, J. Millar. Passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
