

HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION AMENDED

OCTOBER 15, 1990

Be it ordained by the Town of Colebrook:

Section 3. An Historic District Commission is hereby established, consisting of five (5) regular and three alternate members, who shall be electors of the Town of Colebrook, holding no salaried municipal office. One or more of the members or alternates of the Historic District Commission shall reside in an historic district under the jurisdiction of the Commission, if any persons reside in any such district and are willing to serve on such commission. The members of the Commission shall be appointed by town meeting, one to serve until the annual town meeting in October, 1963, one until the annual town meeting in October, 1964, one until the annual town meeting in October, 1965, one until the annual town meeting in October, 1966, and one until the annual town meeting in October, 1967, and at each annual meeting commencing with the annual meeting in October, 1963, one member shall be appointed for a term of five (5) years. The terms of office of the present five (5) alternate members shall expire at the Annual Town Meeting on October 15, 1990. The three alternate members of the Commission shall also be appointed by town meeting beginning October 15, 1990, one to serve three (3) years, one of two (2) years and one of one (1) year. At each annual meeting commencing with the annual meeting in October, 1991, one alternate member shall be appointed for term of three (3) years.

This ordinance shall be effective fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper with a circulation in the Town of Colebrook.
