❖ All dogs over six months old must be licensed.

All dogs must be licensed by June 30th. A \$1 fee is charged for each month late.

- All dogs must have a current rabies vaccination certificate.
- **❖** A license is a lost dog's ticket home.
- Licensing provides vaccination and sterilization benefits for pets.
- **❖** Heartworm disease in dogs is preventable. Talk to your veterinarian.



*New licenses and renewals may be completed by mailing the following to Town Clerk: application or past license paperwork, required documentation (spay/neuter, if applicable, & rabies), payment (check or money order payable to Colebrook Town Clerk), and self-addressed stamped envelope.

*Renewal licensing and payment may be processed online from June 1st – July 31st at www.colebrooktownhall.org/town-clerk/Additional processing fee applies. Rabies vaccine certificates must be current. Tags will be mailed.
