- 1. <u>Meeting Call to Order</u>: Chairman Chris Johnstone called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.
- 2. On a motion by Shayne Young, seconded by Becky Roy, the minutes of the July 8th, 2021 meeting were approved with one abstention.
- 3. Discussion of Projects:
 - A. Silver/Petrucelli; Johnstone stated that he had not received any information from Ken Eldridge regarding updated construction costs.
 - B. Security Grant: Bob Gilbert explained that there were two companies, Vulcan Security and Technology, and P.M. Resources LLC., that have completed security projects for several schools in the area. After a brief discussion of their services, the Board asked Bob Gilbert to contact both companies to set up a date to meet with them. A sub-committee was formed, Andy Bakulski and Chris Johnstone along with Bob Gilbert will meet with the prospective security specialists once Bob is able to set a date for a meeting. Kate Kennedy will contact Board of Finance Chairman, James Millar to clarify the process for approving the 2018 School Security Grant in the amount of \$120,600.
 - C. HVAC No Discussion.
 - D. Status of Current Projects: Bob Gilbert briefed the status of projects that are currently in progress or that will be completed in the near future. Multi-purpose room floor is in progress now; Exterior lighting for the school parking lot will be installed this summer; New Split Rail fencing will be installed by Pleasant Valley Fence this summer; Smart Boards are in the process of being upgraded; funds have been allocated to install interior access to the attic however that project has not moved forward, and funds have been allocated to paint the façade of the school.
