New Business:

Pisgah Mountain Road has been identified as an area in need of special care. The Road, which goes from
the center to Sandy Brook, received scenic road status in May 1989, which means the road and the land
must be maintained in a safe condition, reflecting its scenic designation. Many people walk on this road, and
have noticed the extremely poor conditions there.

At this meeting we heard from three concerned Colebrook citizens regarding the care and maintenance. Abrah Carroll, Harry White and Eric Rochow offered personal observations and concerns and suggestions for resolving the issues. One suggestion is to close/delist the road, at least temporarily, while these problems are worked on. The plan is to meet with the Town Selectmen, taking a walk along the Road to see the problem areas. Suggest that the Road be closed while the problems are remedied. Consider the option of delisting the Road. For this there would need to be consensus of adjacent landowners, the Fire Department, Emergency Services, and so on. It appears that these entities are for the most part in agreement already.

Consider forming an ad hoc group, perhaps called "Friends of Pisgah Mountain" with people who would work on the legal requirements, people who would volunteer to work on road maintenance, plant maintenance, etc.
