To apply for a Colebrook Associates, Inc. Scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. The applicant must be a resident of Colebrook.
- 2. The applicant must be continuing his/her education as a new or continuing student.
- 3. Education must be at an accredited four-year, two year, or certificate-granting institution. (Scholarships are not granted for career-related continuing education).
- 4. A completed scholarship application must be submitted by the due date.
- 5. Include the most current transcript of grades at the time of application.

 A letter of recommendation must accompany the application.
- 6. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.
- 7. All applications must be postmarked or electronically submitted by the last Friday in April.

IT IS THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SUBMIT ALL PARTS OF THE APPLICATION BY THE DEADLINE. NO LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
