SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Over the years, Colebrook Associates, Inc. has provided assistance to families and individuals including the awarding of scholarships to Colebrook residents.

To apply for a Colebrook Associates, Inc. Scholarship, the following requirements must be met:

1. The applicant must be a resident of Colebrook.
2. The applicant must be continuing his/her education as a new or continuing student.
3. Education must be at an accredited four-year, two year, or certificate-granting institution. (Scholarships are not granted for career-related continuing education).
4. A completed scholarship application must be submitted by the due date.
5. **Include the most current transcript of grades at the time of application.**
A letter of recommendation must accompany the application.
6. **Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.**
7. **All applications must be postmarked or electronically submitted by the last Friday in April.**

IT IS THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SUBMIT ALL PARTS OF THE APPLICATION BY THE DEADLINE. NO LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
