If it's an emergency, call 860-379-3359 Ext 201 (Town Hall) If you would like to be included on a trip, come in and sign up and pay the fee and you will secure your reservation. There will be no exceptions. Please see the Trip Policy.

Trip Policy: January 1, 2023

Upon signing up for a trip, it is required that each person pay for the trip and the van cost immediately when he or she signs up for the trip. This will insure your reservation. *** The bus fare fee will be determined on the mileage of the trip and how many people attend. This increase in price is because of the rising cost of gas and the van only getting 10 miles per gallon. The more people that join in on trips; the less the cost. Thank you for your understanding. * If there isn't enough interest in a trip (6 or more, local van trips) and the trip doesn't happen because of this, your van trip money will be returned to you, or you can use it on another trip. *If you cancel on a pending trip, the Director will have the discretion to decide if a refund is warranted.

Feet First: Foot Clinics by Visiting Nurse and Hospice of Litchfield County

The first step is to call 860-379-8561 for a telephone Screening. Appointments must be made to attend the clinics, which are located in Torrington and Winsted for which there is a \$30 charge collected at the time the care is given. The clinics are open to persons who do not have peripheral vascular disease, diabetes or have extreme foot swelling. **The Foot Clinic will no longer be offered in Colebrook.**

<u>Blood Pressure Clinic:</u> Blood Pressure Clinic by Foothills Visiting Nurse and Hospice of Litchfield County is offered on the third Tuesday of the month (March 21, 2023) from 8:40am to 9:40am, free of charge!




