MINUTES

Tuesday, June 4th, 2024

1. The meeting was called to order at 4 p.m. at the Town Garage.
 - a. Members present: Brad Bremer, Dick Perry, and Duncan Wilber
 - b. Members absent: Dennis Gomez
 - c. Others present: none
2. DPW Foreman Bill Jasmin provided an update on paving projects for July including:
 - a. Eno Hill Rd.
 - b. Forge Firehouse parking lot
 - c. Old Forge Rd.
 - d. Robertsville Rd.
3. Three drainage projects were discussed:
 - a. Post Office parking lot (Town is seeking bids)
 - b. Community & Senior Center parking lot – work to be handled by DPW crew and completed prior to Labor Day
 - c. 35 Cobb City Rd. – Town is studying existing drain to determine where existing structure daylight
4. Tree removal – Paused except for critical needs, pending new Town budget.
5. Town garage upgrades were discussed, as well as the possibility of a State grant for a new on-site equipment storage facility.
6. Equipment maintenance was discussed; next step is to have the backhoe's transmission evaluated to determine the viability of investing further in this piece of equipment; the possibility of using further State grant funds to purchase a new backhoe and a used mini excavator was discussed.
7. Next meeting – July 2nd at Town Hall at 4 p.m.
8. The meeting was adjourned at 5 p.m.
