- 1. The Regular Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. Chairman Wilber distributed the 2025-26 Budget Worksheet with known data. The board reviewed the grand list and revenue assumptions.
- 3. Using the 2025-26 Budget Worksheet, the board discussed the mill rate outlook and potential issues, making recommendations for changes in the worksheet for several categories for the next meeting.
- 4. There was only limited discussion of the Colebrook Board of Education's proposed budget with further discussion likely at our next meeting.
- 5. There was no further discussion now of the Board of Selectmen's proposed budget.
- 6. Discussion of the Regional School District Number 7 budget centered around the increase in assessment to Colebrook and the outlook for future assessment given student population changes. The Region 7 budget presentation will take place on March 19, 2025.
- 7. Discussion on funding amount to the CIP budget centered around changing the worksheet assumption from \$450,000 to \$400,000 for further discussion at the next meeting.
- 8. The Board of Finance Regular Meeting Minutes of February 27, 2025, were reviewed. K. Adams made a motion, seconded by C. Huften, "*Motion to approve the February 20, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes.*" Motion passed unanimously.
- 9. The board discussed changes to the motor vehicle assessment rate. The option state statute gives towns to increase the assessment rate from 85% to 90% was noted, however the board did not feel it was within the board's purview to make a recommendation on change to the Board of Selectmen and no motion was made to do so.
- 10. Motion was made by S. Norton, seconded by T. McKeon, to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
