      - 6. The Town of Colebrook will provide Kim Janek with a 1099 as needed.
  - 7. This plan will be reviewed once yearly in September Motion-Mary, Tiffanie second, all were in favor of approving the above plan for karate.
    - d. Baseball signs-Mary will update the sponsor letters so we can get them out ASAP
    - e. Digitizing Our Records-Kim Thomas has set up a google drive with organized folders for us to get this process started.
