

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. in the Town Hall second floor meeting room.
2. There was no public comment.
3. Minutes from the January 12<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved as distributed.
4. The Road Foreman's report was accepted.
5. There were no Legal issues to discuss.
6. Alyssa Correll moved that the Board appoint Info Quick Solutions as Land Record Examiner. AJ Ruwet seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
7. AJ Ruwet moved that the Board accept the Tax Abatement Schedule submitted by Fire Chief Sean Barry. Alyssa Correll seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
8. AJ Ruwet moved that the town increase Building Permit fees to \$15 per thousand of constructed value, including state portion. Alyssa Correll seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
9. Alyssa Correll moved that the Board accept a proposal by Environmental Systems Co. to implement a lighting/energy efficiency program for Town Hall and the Community & Senior Center. AJ Ruwet seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
10. The status of the FY 2025/26 budget was discussed, as well as the FY 2026/27 budget process. The Board will consider its FY 26/27 budget at a Special Meeting on Monday, February 19<sup>th</sup>. The Board will present its recommended FY 26/27 Selectmen's budget to the Board of Finance on Thursday, February 26<sup>th</sup>.
11. Alyssa Correll moved that an item be added to the agenda to adopt a mission statement for the Town. AJ Ruwet seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
12. AJ Ruwet move that the Town adopt the following mission statement, *"The mission of the Town of Colebrook is to serve our residents with integrity, transparency and dedication—preserving the rich heritage of our rural community while fostering growth, environmental stewardship, and civic participation. We strive to ensure a high quality of life for all by maintaining essential services, supporting local traditions and businesses, and planning thoughtfully for the future of our town."*

13. No tax refunds were presented.
14. Bills were approved as presented.
15. Meeting adjourned at 7:29 p.m. on a motion by Alyssa Correll, seconded by AJ Ruwet.
