

Beaver Pond Walk

Directions: From Rt. 8 (Colebrook River Rd) in Colebrook, turn into the entrance gate to US Army Corps. The address is 426A Colebrook River Rd. Drive a short distance to the Administration Building on the left and park in its parking lot.

Note: the boat launch area for the reservoir is farther up on Rt. 8 and is NOT where we will meet.
