A dryer is needed so we can wash our gear after a structure fire.

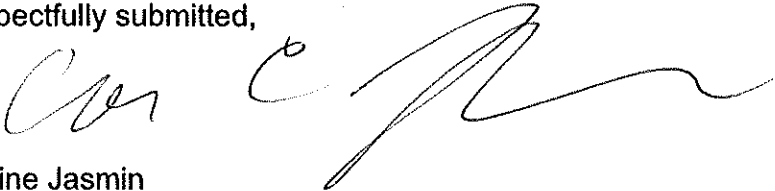
Drill next week will be to acquaint ourselves with the GripHoist and training will be at Zygmunt Excavating.
