Get connected with a laptop from your public library!

WHAT IS IT?

LaptopConneCT lets eligible Connecticut residents borrow a laptop and accessories for long-term use from a participating local library.

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

You can apply for a laptop if you*:

- Are at least 18 years old
- Have a valid and good standing library card

You must also be in one of the following assistance programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP)
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Medicare
- HUSKY Health (Medicaid/The Children's Health Insurance Program)

WHAT STEPS DO I NEED TO TAKE?

Before you get your laptop, you must attend two meetings:

Eligibility & Intake:

A meeting with your librarian to check if you qualify.

Skills Training & Device

Distribution: A session to learn how to use your laptop and pick it up.
